Translation Network Services

Funded by the Ontario Ministry of Health, the Translation Network provides FREE quality translation, from English to French, of documents intended for patients, clients, families and the general public.

- The Translation Network is staffed by professional translators who also utilize the services of freelance translators.
- Access to services is restricted to designated or identified health service providers (HSPs). Some 340 HSPs have access to these services.
- The Translation Network is able to translate a wide variety of documents, for example: forms, brochures, fact sheets, patient education guides, presentations, web sites, correspondence, surveys, signage, recruitment ads, etc.
- Documents may be in a variety of formats, i.e. Word, PowerPoint, Publisher and PDF.
- Proofreading of materials translated through the Network is also available.
- Examples of what the Translation Network does <u>not</u> translate: patient files, material intended for health care professionals or other agencies, internal documents, material required for clinical trials or research studies, copyrighted material, etc.
- The Network is happy to provide the names of qualified freelance translators for materials that do not meet the Network's Guidelines.
- To access services, clients simply complete a request form and e-mail the documents requiring translation.
