Responsibilities

- Facilitate referral of clients to specialist, hospital or community resources as appropriate.
- Participate in case conferences with other providers to ensure coordination of services to the client.
- Ensure that standards of client care are maintained according to accepted College of Nurses standards, the Regulated Health Professions Act, and the policies of BCCHC.
- Perform necessary back-up clinical functions for other nursing staff in their absence.
- Work collaboratively with health promotion team in the design and implementation of services and programs to address the social determinants of health.
